CLIENT-REPORTED OUTCOMES

We engage an independent research firm to deliver anonymous, voluntary surveys, that serve to measure and track the quality of our client experiences, identify emerging issues and areas of improvement and highlight service delivery factors that impact outcomes for our clients. A few of the results from 2021 include:

- The vast majority (93%) reported some problem resolution
- Lower levels of anxiety, depression, psychological and work-related distress and presenteeism
- Higher work engagement, productivity, resilience and life satisfaction
- Of those who had been on disability or absent from work when counselling began (11%) and returned to work during or shortly after using the services (65%), 100% reported that counselling helped in their return to work
